

## NOTICE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS, LEARNERS, AND FACILITATORS

Parents/Guardians, Learners, and Facilitators,

Pursuant to Education Code 35186, you are hereby notified that:

- 1. There should be sufficient textbooks and instructional materials. That means each learner, including an English learner, must have a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home.
- 2. School facilities must be clean, safe, and maintained in good repair.
- 3. There should be no facilitator vacancies or misassignments. There should be a facilitator assigned to each class and not a series of substitutes or other temporary facilitators. The facilitator should have the proper credential to teach the class, including the certification required to teach English learners, if present.

*Misassignment* means the placement of a certificated employee in a teaching or services position for which the employee does not hold a legally recognized certificate or credential or the placement of a certificated employee in a teaching or services position that the employee is not otherwise authorized by statute to hold.

*Facilitator vacancy* means a position to which a single designated certificated employee has not been assigned at the beginning of the year for an entire year or, if the position is for a one-semester course, a position to which a single designated certificated employee has not been assigned at the beginning of a semester for an entire semester.

If you choose to file a complaint alleging that any of the above conditions is not being met, your complaint will be addressed through the district's Williams uniform complaint procedures as required by law. A complaint form may be obtained at the school office or district office, or downloaded from the school or district website. You may also download a copy of the California Department of Education complaint form from the <u>California Department of Education website HERE</u>. However, a complaint can also be filed using CLCS Complaint Form.
