

## **Alameda Community Learning Center Policy Related to Dodge Ball**

Whereas the National Association for Sports and Physical Education has adopted the position that dodgeball is not an appropriate activity for K-12 school physical education programs (National Association for Sport and Physical Education. (2006). Position on dodgeball in physical education [Position statement]. Reston, VA: Author <http://www.aahperd.org/naspe/standards/upload/Position-on-Dodgeball-in-PE-2006.pdf>), and the ACLC Governing Board recognizes that in all other cases ACLC does not condone learners throwing objects at one another, nor does it wish to ask the ACLC Lead Facilitator to defend this practice, the ACLC Governing Board hereby agrees with the NASPE policy and deems that dodgeball is not an appropriate school-sanctioned activity for the Alameda Community Learning Center.
